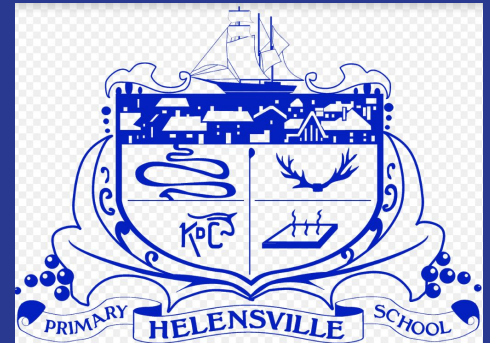

Making Judgements

Twice a year teachers make judgements to decide whether students are 'Working Towards', 'Working At' or 'Working Beyond' in Reading, Writing and Maths.

Judgements are based on a range of sources; assessment data, book work, conferencing, anecdotal notes, observation and so on

In general terms, 'Working Towards' means a student is around a year or more below expectation, 'Working Beyond' a year or more above expectation. There are no definites, teachers moderate to reach agreement on judgements made.

Expectations are based on the New Zealand Curriculum levels
